
2023 ANNUAL REPORT

WORTHY MENTORING



1st Place - \$10,000 Prize Winner

Worthy Mentoring provides tools and resources that empower LGBTQ+ individuals to come out and thrive. Their Worthy Mentoring App connects verified and vetted individuals passionate about supporting others in their coming-out journey with those struggling in the LGBTQ+ community. Both mentors and mentees are presented with professional resources, guides, and handbooks in partnership with many foundations such as the Trevor Project to facilitate successful and empowering mentorship.



2nd Place - \$3,000 Prize Winner

The New 3Rs offers programs and resources to educate and empower children, parents, educators, and workplace leaders through a lens of racial justice and racial awareness. Teaching the contributions Black people have given the world, it is the only online Black History program for 6th to 10th graders. With an exclusive collection of 10,000 Black History Artifacts, the New 3Rs educates and empowers through the aRt of social justice storytelling, building Relationships, and fostering a sense of Responsibility. They seek to create a more Civic and Compassionate Society - One Child at a Time.

3rd Place - \$1,000 Prize Winner

Student Clinic for Immigrant Justice is a youth-led organization that trains and mobilizes college students to provide pro bono legal support to asylum seekers and organize for immigrant justice. SCIJ has trained 84 students, most of whom are immigrants and first-generation Americans. They have provided 125 asylum seekers with legal support and connected 108 immigrants to social services. They recognize that, throughout the immigration process, immigrants face complex legal procedures and policies, transportation barriers, language barriers, and financial barriers.


