LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends of The Greater Sum,

Entrepreneurship requires a lot of energy under any circumstances, and running a start-up non-profit during a pandemic can be mentally, physically, and emotionally exhausting. The non-profit leaders who completed Greater Sum's virtual incubator in 2021 were not only continuing to meet the needs of their communities but were also using their spare time to think about organizational growth and sustainability.

Greater Sum's mission is to support non-profit innovation, and this year that mission held extra meaning. In 2021, we opened our virtual doors to over 40 nonprofit leaders, offering an 8-week incubator program, a 2-day virtual summit, and a 6-month accelerator program. With the help of volunteers and donors, we were able to award \$15,000 in pitch competition prizes and match \$38,000 in individual donations, infusing a total of \$91,000 into this year's cohort of nonprofits. Program participants lent support to each other through our popular peer chats, and program alumni returned to serve as subject matter expert volunteers and summit panelists.

Ong's three keys to help improve interactions and networking in virtual settings:

- 1. "Focus on building relationships" despite the increased difficulty of reading emotions and empathizing in a virtual environment,
- 2. "Improve the quality of conversations" by getting people interested in a setting that inherently decreases attention spans, and
- 3. "Build structures to facilitate serendipity" by being a key player in formulating systems that foster togetherness.

Sexual Violence Prevention Association (SVPA) takes a systemic approach to sexual violence prevention primarily across college campuses by revolutionizing public policy, research, and institutional data. By 2022, SVPA will increase sexual violence prevention across all ages, genders, body types, and socio-economic levels for over 130,000 students. They have displayed significant efforts towards organizational transparency and growth by maintaining a clear and accountable evaluation process for the data they collect, and pushing for public acknowledgement of the issue of sexual violence. Just recently, SVPA founder Omny Martone testified before the Department of Education advocating for the expansion of Title IX to include preventing campus sexual assault.
